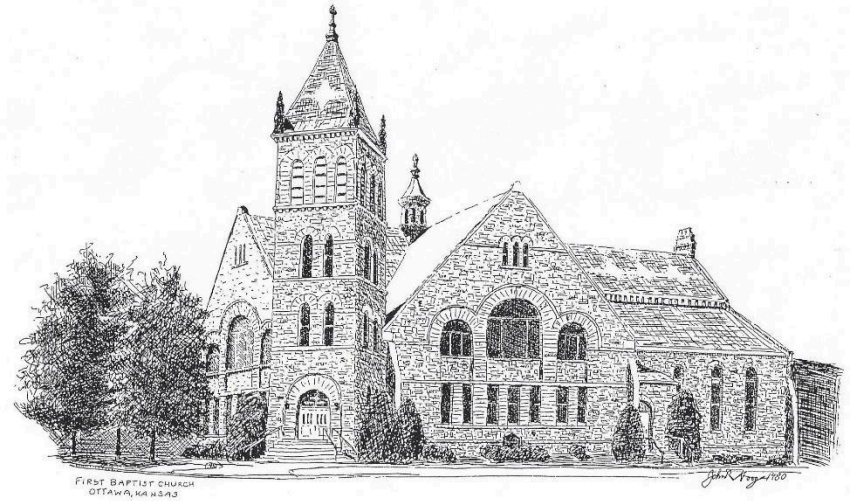


Cynthia's mother, Geneva Stocker, passed away February 15th. Please keep Pastor Tiger, Cynthia and her family in your prayers.
