Please use designated envelopes in the pews if you would like to receive a yearly tax contribution statement for your **cash** offerings.

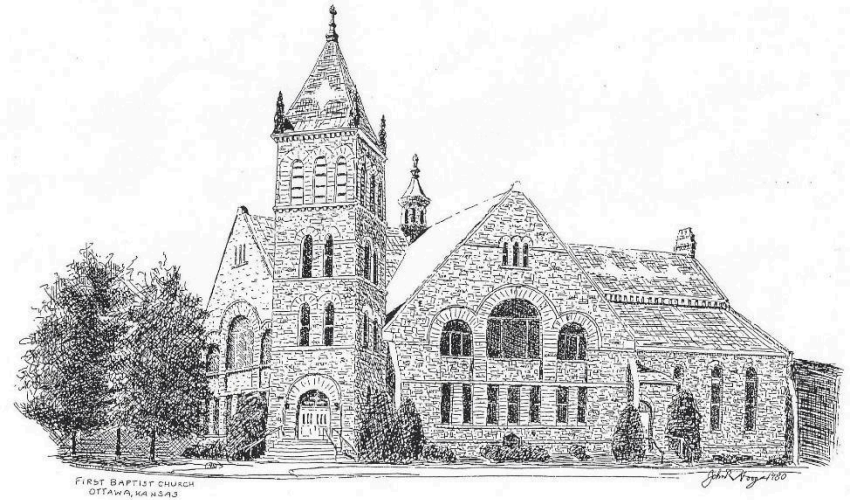
