

Update on Frankie

Hello! I have some more great news about Frankie's progression. About three weeks ago we took her in for an EEG at Children's Mercy which came back as normal. While it is still very possible to have seizures and have a normal EEG, it shows that she will likely not have epilepsy. Since her scan came back as regular, we got clearance to wean her off of her anti-seizure medication! We had started talking about the possibility of taking her feeding tube out soon a couple of months ago due to her not needing it, and decided that we would wait for the results of the EEG to decide if it would come out. Her feeding tube came out this past monday and is healing very well. We are still seeing all of her therapists/specialists and making sure that she starts her life off on the best footing possible. She's able to eat most things that we can, so long as it is smashed enough. She's starting to roll around to get places, to the point that we can't take our eyes off of her, and she's starting to grow out of a lot of the stuff that we got before she was born. She is not very tall but has a very long torso. She is an extremely happy baby and loves to play all the time. So all in all, it's all very good news. She is doing everything that she is supposed to do, and then some. With her initial prognosis her progression is nothing short of a miracle. We are still keeping a close eye out for issues, but we are taking a lot of solace in the fact that no major issue has popped up yet. Thank you for all that you guys do!!
