### White Cross Tree Announcement

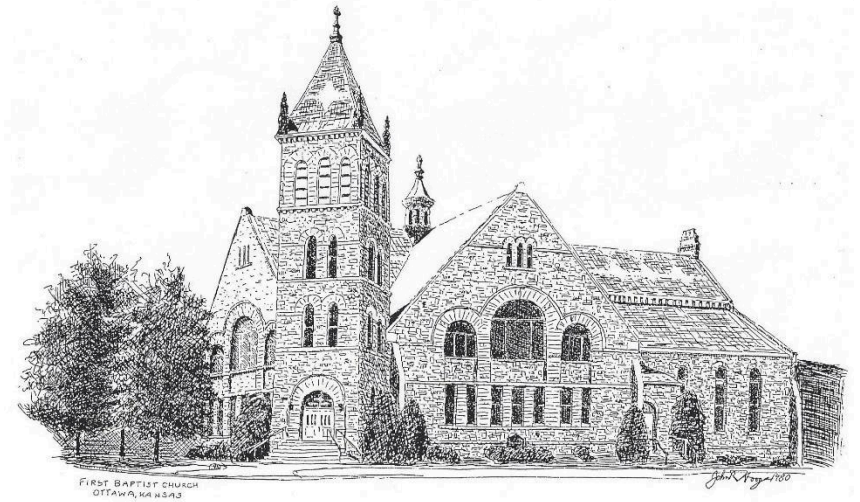
The American Baptist Women invite all members of the congregation to
