This is our last Sunday to collect for The American Baptist One Great Hour of Sharing (OGHS). So far **\$852** has been collected.

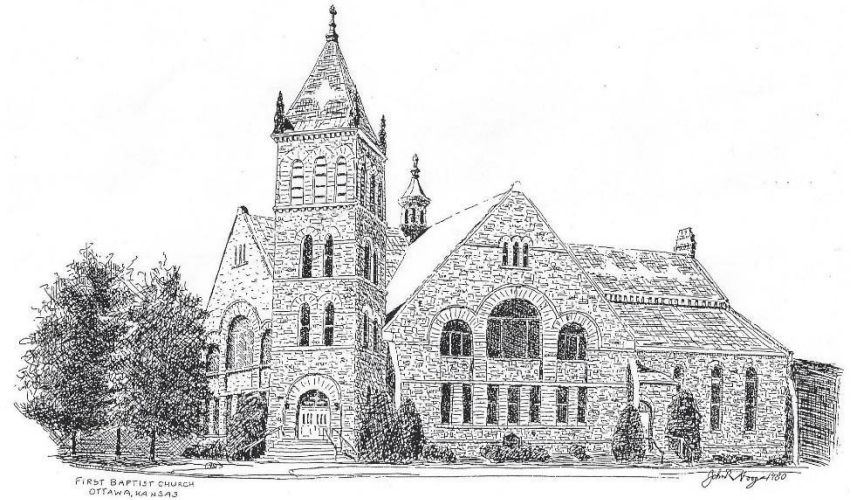
Location Change
